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Detail

The [Devon Rural Housing Partnership](#) manages the Rural Housing Enabler programme and forms part of the Devon Strategic Housing Group.

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Since 2011 the Rural Housing team has been operating as a social enterprise in order to generate the income required to continue operating with reduced public funding. A more focused governance structure has been introduced. The new Delivery Board will work to implement the Business Plan and to drive forward delivery of affordable homes. The Rural Housing Enablers have continued to work on improving the surveys and reports and the collection and presentation of data to allow detailed scrutiny of the pipeline and monitoring of affordable housing delivery across rural Devon.

Details (cont.)

The Devon Strategic Housing Group provides a coordinating function for housing interests, collectively addressing common issues, and acts as a steering group for County wide initiatives and the LAA. It consists of representatives from the Housing Authorities; Registered Providers; Supporting People; HCA; Government Office; Devon Housing Options; Devon Rural Housing Partnership; Private Sector Renewal; County Council. The Devon Strategic Housing Group has responsibility for progressing the Devon wide Tenancy Strategy, and for presenting a single view to strategic authorities on housing matters across the County as a whole.
