**Detail**

To ensure all partners are kept fully informed on affordable housing issues the affordable housing team issues a monthly 'e' newsletter to all elected members, parish councils and Registered Providers.

This provides the latest information on every rural scheme under development .

## Outcomes

The monthly 'e' newsletter ensures that all parties to a scheme are fully informed with progress on that scheme.

It is also a mechanism for enabling all parish councils and elected members to see what other parishes are doing with regard to meeting the affordable housing needs of their local community.

This has encouraged parish councils to develop schemes of their own.
