Objective

<p>Village Information event</p>	<p>To enable the local community to be fully consulted about the details of a proposed scheme, and also to register an interest for a home.</p>
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Detail

A village information event is held for each scheme that is developed, usually just before a planning application is submitted.

This provides the local community with the opportunity to comment on the scheme, to seek full information on the proposal, to confirm an interest in applying for one of the homes, or to object to the scheme.

The event costs the hire of the venue and officer time.

Plans are provided by the partner Registered Provider and usually three sets of these are laid out on three tables so that visitors can view these at leisure.

Outcomes

The outcomes achieved from these events are that all parties are satisfied that the local community is fully consulted and informed on what effectively becomes their scheme.

The local community takes ownership of the scheme, important for its progression.

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
