Quarterly officer group that meets to discuss progress and issues to affect timely delivery of local needs housing schemes.

Rural Round Table includes officers from planning, housing, legal services of the borough council, highways services, developing Registered Providers and the Rural Housing Enabler.

Outcomes

Rural Round Table fosters good relations between officers and enables early identification of issues.

Planning, Highways and Legal issues are discussed, and resolutions found to problems.

This forum highlights issues that need to be addressed at an early stage. It brings different expertise together which aids problem solving.
